Purpose of course:

Consider life expectancy, today. Roughly 10% of the world' population is 60 or older by 2050, that percent will double. In developed nations people over 60 now account for one-fifth of the population, by 2050, they will account for one-third. The main purpose of the course is to give an outline for the old patients.

To gain this purpose, a multidisciplinary approach which has following backgrounds

- Biology of aging
- Path physiology
- Introduction to internal medicine

Formal requirements:

Times New Roman, 12 pt, 1.5 spacing, min. 5000 characters (2-3 A4 pages).

First page: name; year; group; title of subject; essay title.

The essay should be **printed and handed to the teacher** on the lecture **AND** it also should be **uploaded on CooSpace**. Filename: Student's Name_Essay's title.
