



DEAR STUDENTS,

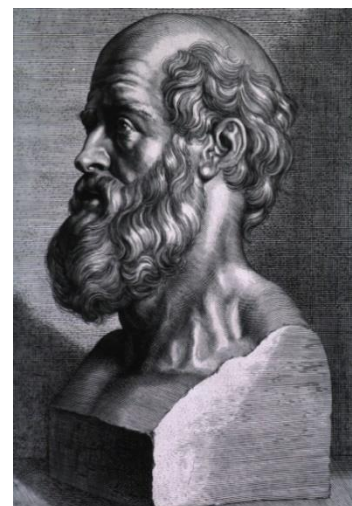

COMPULSORY COURSES:

- ❖ **Introduction to Medicine lecture and practice (2 credits)**
year I., fall semester
- ❖ **Introduction to Psychology, Communication lecture and practice (1 credit)**
year I., spring semester
- ❖ **Medical Anthropology (1 credit)**
year II., spring semester
- ❖ **Medical Psychology I. lecture and practice (2 credits)**
year IV., fall semester
- ❖ **Medical Psychology II. lecture and practice (1 credit)**
year IV., spring semester
- ❖ **Ethics in Medicine lecture and practice (2 credits)**
year IV., spring semester
- ❖ **Doctor-Patient Communication (Criteria course!)**
year IV., fall and spring semester
- ❖ **Examination in Behavioral Science (comprehensive exam)**
