DUTIES AND TASKS OF STUDENTS Social and health policy – 4th and 5th year medical students

Study requirements

Regular and active participation in the lectures is required. The students have to attend the lectures at least seven times during the semester. The students will sign the name-list as a proof of presence. Lecturers will record the attendance on CooSpace, thereby students can follow their absences.

A control test containing 5–10 (test) questions on CooSpace will belong to each lecture. Students must complete the tests till **20**th **April 2023.** Completing the tests will help you to prepare for the exam. The same test can be fulfilled more than once (maximum 3 times), but at least once 60% performance must have to be per each test, which is a condition of signing the semester.

The students' knowledge will be checked by a written demonstration (30 test questions) at the time of the last lecture (11th week – 21st of April).

Calculation of the grade:

27-30 points – excellent (5) 24-26 points – good (4) 20-23 points – satisfactory (3) 18-20 points – passed (2) 17 points and lower – failed (1)

On the base of the result of the written demonstration the teacher may exempt a student from exam by offering a grade. Students must achieve at least satisfactory (3) as grade-offer (SZTE TVSZ 9.3. Grade-offer can only apply to "excellent" or "good" or "satisfactory" evaluations in the case of employing the five-grade scale.) Those students who do not reach the accepted grade OR do not accept the offered grade, can do the exam (written test) during the exam period.

Educational affairs can be managed by EMAIL. Telephone administration is NOT possible. The educational advisor is Csaba Erdős, email: <u>erdos.csaba@med.u-szeged.hu</u>. Emails should contain the full name of the student and faculty, if any of these data is missing then no reply will be.

Criteria of the completition and grade-offer of the course:

- 1. Participation at least seven times on the lectures.
- 2. Completion of each control test with at least 60% performance. The deadline is 20th of April 2023.
